Due to its exceptional geographical location, the province of Huelva is leader in the European market for citrus fruits production.

The coastal strip that extends from the township of Lepe to Isla Cristina hosts the largest production of citrus fruits in Huelva.

Last year, mandarins have overtaken orange as the top-selling citrus fruit. Its production surface covers 80% of the site and it keeps growing.

Huelva is the Spain's third-largest citrus exporter, as well as the main European market for this product.




Huelva is the Europe's largest producer of **strawberries** and the second in the world, after California. This fruit is followed in order of importance by blueberry, raspberry and
