Its communication and access network through Huelva's port, the international airports of Seville and Faro (Portugal), the direct, high-speed railway line to Madrid (AVE) and the connection to the TEN-T (Trans-European Transport Networks) Core Network makes it the most privileged location to compete in a global market.

Huelva is well-known as the Costa de la Luz (Coast of Light) due to its more than 3,000 hours of sunshine per year and 120 km of coast, two qualities that give it a unique appeal for it to produce high-quality products with Designation of Origin. Not for nothing it has recently been declared as the Spanish Capital City of Gastronomy 2017.

HUELVA HAS THE LARGEST PYRITE BELT 87,000 HA



Huelva extract 80% of the metallic minerals in Spain, mainly thanks to the working of Matsa (Almonaster la Real) and Atalaya Mining (Riotinto), both leading companies in Huelva.

It is one of the main focuses for investment with an annual turnover of EUR 350 million.

Huelva has more than 600 land rights to be exploited.

Copper, zinc and lead deposits are particularly important.

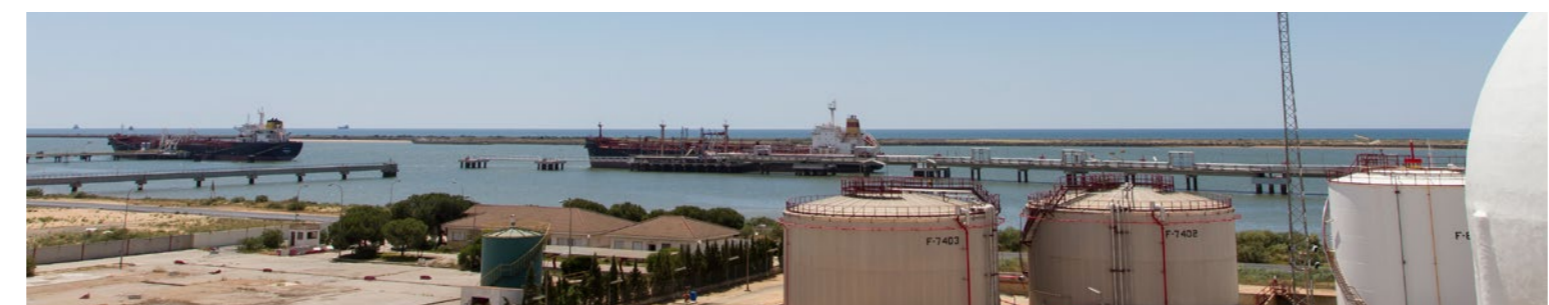
